In our future we will see:

**1. Transport:**

- **In 2060 we want our transport system to be similar to how it is today**
  - **In 2060, in Nelson, we need safe, efficient, new road systems**
  - **In 2060 we want cheap, reliable, regular, environmentally friendly transport systems, and less reliance on fossil fuels and non-renewable resources**
  - **In 2060 we will have advanced technology, along with the ability for freedom**
    - We want cars and private transport to be the same
    - Good roads
    - Better road systems
    - Faster, more economical cars
    - Safe streets
    - Reliable regular public transport
    - Cheap fuel
    - No fossil fuels
    - Solar cars
    - Stop being lazy and walk
    - More motor cross tracks/ skids pads/ racing tracks etc
    - Jet packs

**2. Food:**

- **In 2060 we want our food to be abundant, affordable and fresh**
- **In 2060, we will have more food crops in Nelson, on the Richmond Hills, and will have pest control to protect the food**

    - Better, quicker access to health system and hospitals
    - Population kept down
    - Free medicinal assistance for senior citizens
    - A cure for cancer
    - Free dental care
    - Surgeons/ surgical people
    - Smoking is illegal
    - Make drugs illegal until they have been approved to be OK

### 4. Environment:

- **In 2060, we want our environment to be conserved and valued, and to live harmoniously with it**
- **In 2060, we want less pollution, a clean, green environment, and safe water ways**
- **In 2060, we want more efficient, faster working recycling**
- **In 2060, Nelson will have more re-usable products that create less landfill**
  - But not over-the-top
  - Clean rivers that people can swim in and are open to the public for free
  - Free water and Tibet
  - Clean water
  - Clean beaches
  - Fresh water
  - Clean rivers and streams
  - Safe clean river systems
  - Safe clean public water fountains
  - Open grass areas that are open to the public
  - Strong eco-system
  - A national park
  - National parks – preserved natural environments
  - Produce trees
  - Native trees
  - Protected forests
