



As the major factor contributing to PM10 is the moisture content of the wood being burned it should be feasible to allow NES Air Quality compliant burners which in effect would also allow for the installation of ULED burners. Coupled with education around the best practice for buying , storing and burning dry wood, more people would be enabled to install a new NES burner to keep warm without further degradation of air quality.

The proposed rule will assist only the wealthy to keep warm and they would be better encouraged to invest in heat pumps not new fires.

Alternatively, allow a smaller number of NES compliant burners to be installed to improve peoples ability to finance installation. Evidence shows that people are more likely to become ill from cold homes than the levels of air pollution nelson suffers therefore the goal of warmer homes and therefore better health would be encouraged.

If you took a conservative approach the number of new NES wood burners allowed could be reviewed every 1-2 years and adjusted upwards if PM10 levels were held at acceptable levels

Additional Submission Points: • The current proposal limits installation to four very expensive options, none of which includes a wetback. This limits severely the numbers of people either able to afford one of these options or wish for a wetback to achieve further energy savings.

- Your regulations state that ULEB's cannot exceed 0.5g emissions/kg fuel burnt as stated on your website.

There are of course a number of other low emission burners that do not exceed 0.5g/kg. As an example, the Pyroclassic IV burns only 0.3g/kg.

I only list this one as a recommendation from a friend who has one installed and speaks highly of it both in affordability, meeting environmental standards and includes the option of a wetback.

If the limitation is that the Pyroclassic IV and other similar fires have not been tested under real-life conditions then please do this? That would be a no-brainer!

- I am very concerned that in the interests of air quality, the NCC has not thought about the consequences for many deprived households. I have worked extensively with the refugee community and struggling families and can give numerous examples of families with frequent admission to hospital or unreasonably medicated due to damp and cold houses. These people have heat pumps but do not use them as they cannot afford the electricity bills. They go to bed to keep warm; meanwhile they still breathe in cold air often damp and containing dangerous mould spores.

Meanwhile, I am sitting in my very dry and warm home not least due to our wonderful wood fire....

Submission: Nelson Air Quality Plan Plan Change A3 (Woodburners)

17 January 2016

I submit that the proposed changes to the said plan should be rejected.

1. The proposed changes are contrary to the intention of the Air Quality Plan.

The minimum standards in the Air Quality Plan and the national standards which they express are meters of a regulatory mechanism to improve air quality. They specifically cannot be used as a 'low mark' to which air quality may be reduced by changing regulations to allow increased pollutant loading.

It would be unconscionable to even partly undo the success of air quality regulations where these have resulted in benefits, for to do so would be to undo these benefits (i.e. to regulate against the intentions of the Air Quality Plan and against Council's obligations).

The Air Quality Plan is a mechanism for the continuing improvement of air quality and must not be undermined by contradictory regulation (such as the proposed Plan Change A3).

To regulate to allow 'back fill' of pollutants to the minimum standard where such a minimum has been surpassed by the application of existing regulations intended to surpass that standard would be equivalent to regulating against other public health achievements, for example changing regulations to achieve water pollution levels down to the minimum standard, or changing regulations to allow mercury levels in fish to be increased.

2. The proposed changes are inequitable.

To allow "a limited number" of woodburners to be installed would result in an inequitable attribution of rights. In a given planning zone, permitted activities must be universally permitted and banned activities must be universally banned, except where individual circumstances are exceptional (i.e. not on a first-in, first-served basis).

3. The proposed changes will not achieve the ends intended.

No reason is given in Plan Change A3 for the intention to increase pollutant loading, but media suggest these changes are proposed to appease a vocal lobby group whose concerns are primarily the living conditions, housing and health of the less affluent members of our community.

These are absolutely valid concerns but they will not be effectively addressed by Plan Change A3.

The less affluent member of our community would not benefit from the opportunity to install these woodburners. The types of approved woodburners are unaffordable for the poor. Those in rental accommodation would be unlikely to benefit as landlords would be unlikely to install expensive new burners.

Other potential mechanisms exist by which council may more effectively address the living conditions, housing and health of the less affluent. For example: programmes to encourage and subsidise insulation; warrants of fitness/minimum standards for rental accommodation; rate rebates for the installation of efficient electric heating systems; lobbying central government for regulatory alteration of electricity pricing mechanisms.

Conclusion.

Proposed Plan Change A3 is contrary to the intentions of the Air Quality Plan, it is inequitable and it is ineffective in meeting its (unstated) ends.

I therefore submit that there is no option but to reject the changes detailed in Plan Change A3.

Reasons: There are three points I strongly believe need to be pushed and considered by the consent panel, they are that:

Firstly - Proposed allocation of woodburners should include the allowance of NES (National Emission Standard) compliant burners. Not just allocation of ULEB (ultra low emission burners) burners.

NES burners are approved, proven, readily available and extremely efficient clean burners.

ULEB burners are very expensive and an unproven technology, many also require 240v electrical connection to function. Nobody in the community has asked for these, and local fireplace distributors in Nelson are not keen on them. In fact only one distributor in Nelson has the rights to sell these at present from the new manufacturer.

The pellet burners were also of the same scenario 10 years ago, and on paper sounded good as a new technology, but in practice proved ineffective for heating, unreliable and also relied on dependence on electricity, thus after a couple of years, no one wants these approved pellet burners. My fear is this may well be the case with ULEBs which just a few have achieved this technology and only been around one season in Christchurch to date.

Secondly - There were three options evaluated in the report presented to council by staff in December. Option 1, that was recommended by staff, which was also the most restrictive was voted through in the end as preferred.

Option 3 that was in the report, and was the most suitable. It allows many more homes to have woodburners installed, and greater area of Nelson access, and also achieves compliance with the current NES air quality standards imposed on us. This is shown in the modelling and data given for either ULEB or NES woodburners. It would mean the greatest benefit to home heating by allowing a larger number of woodburners installed compared to the other two options, whilst also achieving the air quality standards imposed on us by central government.

Thirdly – Nelson hospital data, and DHB evaluations and graphed results have shown that respiratory health has worsened since 2004 when the restrictive heating rules were enforced. Prior to that year respiratory illness was improving and inline with rest of NZ and our neighbouring Tasman district. Thus the very month when Nelson had the most restrictive rules in NZ take effect, Nelsons respiratory illness by hospital admissions had measurdly deteriorated, a complete opposite trend to the rest of NZ's DHB figures.

This is clearly shown in Dr Ed Kiddle's report from Nelson DHB, yet he continually claims this is not to be considered valid as these trends don't match his original desired hypothesis. Nor match his acceptance of some US population studies and expectations.

These concerns to health due to the restriction of sensible effective heating by clean efficient woodburners in Nelson are backed up by NZ Asthma society, many Nelson Doctors, and many other health and building experts in the region I have spoken to.

A highly qualified and respected air quality expert in NZ Dr John Hoare spoke to the City Council air quality working party last year and yet all his presentation was dismissed by Council staff as not to be incorporated as expert advice, as it challenged the current negative health assumptions of woodburners.

The NZ environment commissioner Dr Jan Wright has also recently written a report that condemns the methodology of air quality compliance used at present for exceedance levels in NZ. She states it as being incorrect and superseded science by the now international understanding of cause and effect of carbon particulate in the air.

Thus the commissioned consent panel can still consider all 3 options as valid options. Even though option one was voted by majority councillors as preferred, all three or even another alternative can still be decided upon by the panel, after hearing and weighing up the publics submissions.





Re: Submission for Nelson Air Quality Plan – Proposed Plan Change A3

We hereby submit our submission for the above proposed plan change A3.

We are in favour of this change. We live within the area of the proposed change and would welcome the opportunity to install a ULEB within our home.

We have recently built a new home at the above address. It is very warm and 95% of the time functions well with the heating system we have currently installed. At the time of build we would have really liked to have installed a wood burning fire for the following reasons;

- An environmentally friendly form of heating – a carbon neutral fuel.
- A low cost heating alternative.
- An efficient heating system – unlike an open fire, these closed units retain more and give out more heat.
- Extra warmth on non sunny days in the winter period.
- Emergency heating should we ever loose electrical power.
- Atmospheric effect within the home.

The householders within the above address do work from home during the day on occasions (as well as leisure time at weekends) and have noticed that in the winter, even with the existing heating on, on cloudy days when sitting in a one location for a period of time your body does chill to an uncomfortable degree.

Having a past experience of a fire negates this effect as you can warm your body up (as well as the room the fire is in) effectively and comfortably from the warmth of a fire. Nothing seems to beat the warmth that a really fire gives out in terms of a heating system.

We believe it is a basic human right to be able to operate a fire within your own home. Now that certain fires have been proven to be low emission burners, we can see no reason why Nelson City Council cannot grant residents permission to install these new types of fires. It really is common sense and works in line with other councils within New Zealand and other parts of the developed world. London had enormous problems in the past with smog and pollution in the 1950s. Steps were taken by the government and smokeless fuels introduced and certain types of fires restricted. The problem has been solved and now residents can still enjoy and benefit from a real fire under certain correct conditions. We see Nelson being no different only that its current stance is somewhat behind the times and backward thinking when proven alternatives exist that would make living conditions for many of its residents so much better.

Lastly, we do have to say that the clean air in Nelson over the past few years has been a great improvement. Having visited some other areas of the South Island without this clean air policy, the air quality has been just terrible and so Nelson City Council has to be congratulated on cleaning up the air quality.
