<u>THAT</u> Council supports the re-instatement of the Cable Bay Road to provide the same level of service as was provided prior to the December 2011 rainfall event; <u>AND THAT</u> Council approves that design and preliminary works commence in the current (2011/12) financial year (subject to New Zealand Transport Agency funding its share of the emergency works) as part of the funding set aside for recovery work.

<u>AND THAT</u> Council include funding to undertake these works estimated at \$1,912,000 (subject to New Zealand Transport Agency funding its share of the emergency works) in the Long Term Plan for 2012/13 to effect re-instatement to the previous level of service;

<u>AND THAT</u> Council contributes up to \$2500 towards fencing of slip areas to prevent stock access for soil conservation purposes through the land management fencing grant scheme;

<u>AND THAT</u> staff investigate the costs and implications of funding reseeding or replanting of the area of immediate road bank and farmland fenced off from grazing by Ian and Barbara Stuart;

<u>AND THAT</u> Council open the road to all traffic but keep the caution signs and traffic lights in place until the repair work commences.
