8. Lewis Stanton – Trafalgar Street Footpath Occupation – The Way Forward

<u>THAT</u> should Council be inclined to issue a special permit to Mr Stanton that this special permit includes, as a minimum, the following conditions:

- That Mr Stanton collect and suitably dispose of all his horse manure;
- That the term of any special permit issued to Mr Stanton be for a maximum period of 12 months, followed by a review;
- That Mr Stanton be prohibited from using open fires for cooking or heating;

- That Mr Stanton be allowed to use a contained fire (brazier or similar) for heating and the use of a barbeque for cooking purposes for the period permitted in the Nelson Air Quality Plan;
- That Mr Stanton be allowed a maximum of three nights stay at any site;
- That the permit not allow any commercial activity;
- That any special permit allow Mr Stanton access to camp in the following areas close to existing ablution facilities:
 - Branford Park;
 - QEII Drive mounds (adjacent to Founders Path boundary);
 - Guppy Park surrounds;
 - Pioneers Park (St Vincent/Hastings Street corner).
- That access to the following be specifically excluded:
 - All Sports fields;
 - All Horticulture Parks;
 - All public playgrounds;
 - Within 50m of a playground;
 - No closer than 50m within the boundary of any park or reserve;
 - Where there is no access to suitable toilet facilities.

<u>AND THAT</u> should Mr Stanton break the conditions of any special permit that said permit be cancelled immediately.
