# Annual Plan 2013/14 Workshop Discussion Summary

## 1. Purpose of Report

1.1 This report provides a record of discussions during the 2013/14 Annual Plan Workshop. Recommendations based on the guidance provided by Council through the workshop will form direction to staff in the preparation of the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan.

## 2. Background

- 2.1 Annual Plan Workshops were held on 16 October, 15 November and 6 December 2012 and 12-13 February 2013.
- 2.2 Workshop topics included the amendments to the Local Government Act 2002 and in particular changes to the purpose of local government. Council conducted a review of Council activities proposed for inclusion in the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan and their appropriateness in light of the changes to the Act. Councillors reviewed the 2013/14 work programme and provided guidance to staff on projects and funding levels. Other topics of note were community engagement during consultation on the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan, a review of the Annual Plan process and changes to the Local Authority Protection Programme (LAPP). The workshops finished with a review of variations to funding in Year 2 of the Long Term Plan.

#### 3. Discussion

#### **New Purpose**

The Manager Policy and Planning, Nicky McDonald, made a presentation on changes to the purpose of local government, legal interpretation of the new legislation and possible impacts on Council's work programme. Councillors undertook a review of Council activities proposed to be included in the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan (Attachment 1) and focussed in particular on any projects that they felt might not fall within the parameters of the new definition. Staff provided a list of projects that required careful consideration and Councillors gave the following direction:

3.2 Items marked for transition were those that Council felt were no longer a good fit with the purpose of local government. However, where there were commitments to community groups and expectations of ongoing funding, transition arrangements should be discussed over the course of

the 2013/14 year, and possibly future years, to allow alternative funding to be sought by groups so that valuable community programmes would not be placed at risk.

THAT funding for the Holiday Programme Grants, After School Programme, Youth Programme, Recreation Preschool Programme, Enviro education schools, Enviroschool facilitation, Enviroschools co-ordination, Youth Development Fund, Youth Nelson and the Social Wellbeing Policy Action Plan be reviewed in order to align with the new purpose of local government with the intention to cease funding in the medium term:

<u>AND THAT</u> the groups that will be affected by the transition from Council support be advised of the potential change and the reasons for it.

- 3.3 Staff provided Councillors with a list of projects that appeared to still be appropriate activities for Council but which should be viewed again in relation to the new purpose. Councillors gave careful consideration to these projects and their fit with the new purpose statement. The consensus of Councillors appeared to be that these projects did align, also noting that the community would have the opportunity to provide feedback on the appropriateness of the work programme to the purpose, through the Annual Plan consultation. Staff noted that information about the new purpose and other changes to the Local Government Act 2002 would be provided to ratepayers in advance of and during the Annual Plan consultation.
- 3.4 There was discussion on the Community Assistance Programme and Councillors' initial view was that the overall funding would need consideration to see if it might need to transition to a lower level. Staff were also asked to review the criteria in light of the new purpose.

<u>THAT</u> the criteria for grants from the Community Assistance Programme be reviewed before the next application round.

3.5 Councillors also turned their attention to the list of all other projects proposed for the 2013/14 work programme and listed any that were of possible concern in relation to fit with the new purpose. Following a period of discussion on each of these projects in turn, there appeared to be a consensus view that all of them fitted within the purpose of local government and should be continued.

THAT projects identified in sections one and two of the work programme matrix (1451181, excluding the 15 projects headed 'Projects that require careful consideration') continue to be funded through the 2012-22 Long Term Plan on

the basis that they fall within the scope of the new purpose of local government as set out in the Local Government Act 2002.

## **Trafalgar Centre**

- 3.6 The Principal Advisor Reserves and Community Facilities,
  Andrew Petheram, briefed Councillors on issues facing the Trafalgar
  Centre.
- 3.7 There was general agreement that the project should continue in 2013/14 whilst ensuring that the funds allocated to the project were spent wisely. There was also agreement that a detailed earthquake assessment and geotechnical report was a priority. Councillors were also concerned to ensure that any works were aesthetically pleasing and addressed the substandard public amenities of the Victory Room, toilets and kitchen.
- 3.8 Councillors discussed several options. Officers were requested to progress detailed earthquake and geotechnical assessments for the Trafalgar Centre in the current financial year. An allocation of \$3 million was to be made in the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan to address the issues of earthquake strengthening, liquefaction investigation and amenity improvements. It is foreseen that the remainder of the budget will be spent in the 2014/15 year.

<u>THAT</u> detailed earthquake and geotechnical assessments of the Trafalgar Centre be undertaken in 2012/13;

AND THAT \$3 million of the total Long Term Plan allocation of \$10.237 million be provided in the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan to address the issues of earthquake strengthening and amenity improvements at the Trafalgar Centre;

AND THAT \$6.452 million of the total Long Term Plan allocation be provided in 2014/15.

#### **Utilities**

- 3.9 The Principal Adviser Utilities, Phil Ruffell, addressed the issues facing the York Stream, Corder Park Pump Station, Marsden Valley Wastewater and Observatory Hill Water Reservoir and Pump Station projects. He advised that detailed design had allowed more accurate construction estimates and that current and future projects had been reviewed to help fund the increased budget demands of these projects.
- 3.10 York Stream construction cost is to be supported by the Stormwater renewals budget.
- 3.11 Corder Park Pump Station is proposed to be supported by wastewater renewals budget, deferring a small number of wastewater projects and

- bringing forward capital expenditure for the Neale Park Pump Station project.
- 3.12 Marsden Valley Wastewater upgrade is to be supported by bringing forward capital expenditure on the Marsden Valley Express Sewer and Arapiki/Quarantine projects.
- 3.13 Observatory Hill Water Reservoir and Pump Station will be supported by expected savings in the construction costs of the Maitai Duplicate Water Pipeline.
- 3.14 The cost difference in providing the Observatory Hill reservoir with or without a viewing platform for the public was identified to councillors. The spectacular view from the old platform was acknowledged; advice from officers after the workshop is it is difficult to identify the exact difference in cost. For that reason, it is suggested that the project be tendered and referred to Council for cost comparison and decision.
- 3.15 After discussion amongst Councillors, the direction of the majority was as below:

<u>THAT</u> \$1.7 million be allocated for the upgrade of the York Stream flood capacity in the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan;

<u>AND THAT</u> the redevelopment of Corder Park Pump Station be deferred to the 2014/15 financial year;

AND THAT \$1.5 million be allocated in the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan for the upgrade of the Marsden Valley reticulation;

AND THAT the Observatory Hill Water Reservoir and Pump Station project progresses, with the allocation of an additional \$600,000; noting however that the project will be tendered and referred to Council for comparison of costs with or without the public viewing platform.

#### **Transport**

- 3.16 At the December 2012 workshop Council staff had recommended deferring several projects. Councillors saw the following as a priority:
  - 1. Parking Strategy;
  - 2. Southern Arterial Corridor Management Plan; and
  - 3. Regional Land Transport Strategy/Regional Land Transport Programme updates from Issues Definition Report.

3.17 Councillors asked for an update on top of the south roading and the implications of the Road Maintenance Taskforce Report. Staff advised that a report would be on the agenda of the 4 April 2013 Infrastructure Council meeting.

#### Resourcing

3.18 The Chief Executive spoke about her concerns around work currently not being undertaken, particularly but not exclusively in the transport and recreation areas. Councillors agreed to \$200,000 being added to the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan, noting that the Chief Executive would speak with them further in March on this issue.

<u>THAT</u> a provision of \$200,000 be added to the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan for staffing to address outstanding work, subject to further advice from the Chief Executive.

## **Cricket World Cup**

- 3.19 After an update on the Cricket World Cup 2015 bid from the Project Management Adviser, Chris Blythe, Council agreed that a portion of the 2014/15 financial allocation needed to be brought forward into 2013/14 for additional external staff funding.
- 3.20 (On the second day of workshop, the Chief Financial Officer, Nikki Harrison, proposed that \$250,000 funding be pulled forward into the 2014/15 year for both Cricket World Cup and FIFA.)
- 3.21 As the Cricket World Cup funding information was contained in a public excluded meeting of Council, Councillors need to agree to release the information in order to comment on this in the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan.

THAT a provision of \$250,000 of the funding allocation be brought forward from 2014/15 into the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan for potential commitments around Cricket World Cup and Fédération Internationale de Football Association (FIFA) external staffing requirements;

<u>AND THAT</u> the total cost to ratepayers of the Cricket World Cup bid is released from public excluded.

## **Earthquake Prone Buildings**

3.22 The Executive Manager Network Services, Alec Louverdis, briefed Councillors on the issues facing Council owned buildings that were earthquake prone. Mr Louverdis explained the process of initial and detailed assessments and asked for guidance on timeframes and funding.

3.23 There was discussion on the territorial authority's processes for administering the Earthquake Prone, Dangerous and Insanitary Building Policy, the Crown's discussion document on Building Seismic Performance and any obligations of the Council towards privately-owned earthquake prone buildings. There was a consensus view that investing funds in remediating earthquake prone buildings was an appropriate Council activity where clear criteria for Council involvement was set for that investment and it was within the new purpose of local government.

THAT \$300,000 be allocated in 2013/14 for the detailed assessments of Council-owned earthquake prone buildings, followed by \$300,000 in 2014/15;

<u>AND THAT</u> tenants of Council-owned buildings are notified of the results of initial assessments;

AND THAT consideration be given to Council reviewing assessment results and that it be afforded the opportunity to prioritise required work prior to advising the Building Consent Authority.

- 3.24 After the provision of further information specifically on the buildings at 23 Halifax Street (Prego Mediterranean Foods) and 23 New Street (Bata), Councillors considered the buildings separately.
- 3.25 Councillors were advised that a \$400,000 allocation would be suitable for progressing 23 Halifax Street (either strengthening or demolition, to be determined by Council after considering a full report). Subsequent advice from officers is that \$500,000 will be required.

<u>THAT</u> a \$500,000 allocation be added to the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan to be used for earthquake strengthening or demolition of the building at 23 Halifax Street, as determined by Council following a staff report.

THAT a \$300,000 allocation be added to the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan to be used for the demolition of the building at 23 New Street, its replacement with a carpark and a final decision on the future of the site to be made following consideration of the Parking Study;

AND THAT the write-off of the residual \$149,000 loan on the Bata Building be funded in 2013/14.

#### **Nelson School of Music**

3.26 Councillors also discussed the Nelson School of Music, noting that while discussions were progressing well, legal agreements were taking longer to finalise than predicted as the Board wished to ensure it understood

Council's commitment to the School. It would therefore be necessary to move some of the capital out a year to 2013/14 as transfer of assets to the Council was unlikely to occur before April 2013 and that would delay the start of the earthquake strengthening/refurbishment project. Given the complexities of the project and the need to undertake detailed planning, it was unlikely that physical work (and cost) could be started before July 2014. Whilst this seemed a long way out, it was appropriate for Council to recognise likely delays in its capital expenditure programme.

3.27 Subsequent to the workshop, Nelson School of Music has raised the issue of an outstanding mortgage on the property; this currently stands at \$165,000 and will need to be settled as soon as the property is transferred. The best way to handle this quantum will need to be further considered by Council when it confirms the Annual Plan.

<u>THAT</u> \$300,000 of the funding allocated in the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan for the purposes of earthquake strengthening and refurbishing the Nelson School of Music be deferred to the 2014/15 financial year;

<u>AND THAT</u> Council note the outstanding mortgage on the property of \$165,000 and consider this when adopting the Annual Plan.

## **State Advances Building**

3.28 Councillors discussed the State Advances Building, and on the basis of information from staff, indicated that they were happy for staff to progress as follows:

THAT \$50,000 be added to the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan for the purposes of preparing a business case with options for the State Advances building.

#### **Annual Plan Financials**

3.29 Under the guidance of the Chief Financial Officer, Nikki Harrison, Councillors reviewed the capital programme for 2013/14. After discussion, the Annual Plan Workshop Capital Variances for Year 2 spreadsheet (the document circulated at the workshop) (Attachment 2) were seen as an appropriate base for the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan.

<u>THAT</u> the Annual Plan Workshop Capital Variances For Year 2 spreadsheet (1454906) be accepted as a basis of changes to the capital programme, as set out in the Long Term Plan 2012-2022.

3.30 There was discussion of the Events Contestable Funding, and the view of councillors was that the fund criteria and policy should be reviewed.

# <u>THAT</u> the Events Contestable Fund policy and criteria be reviewed.

#### 4. Further Information Required

4.1 Councillors requested further information on several projects. An update from staff follows.

## **Church St Improvements**

- 4.2 The Church St project is a key part of the ongoing implementation of the Heart of Nelson Strategy. However, staff consider the investigation work would be better delayed to 2013/14 so that design and planning of Upper Trafalgar St/Selwyn Place (another Heart of Nelson project) and Church Street can be better integrated.
- 4.3 The Long Term Plan has funding in 2012/13 for Church Street of \$15,000 for an investigation, and 2013/14 funding of \$41,552 for commencement of construction (with construction finishing in 2014/15). Staff propose that \$15,000 be carried over from 2012/13 into 2013/14 and the 2013/14 funding of \$41,552 move to 2014/15.

## Flood Mitigation

4.4 As a result of the December 2011 storm event, repair work to the value of \$300,000 has been identified for parts of the streams in Brook, Enner Glynn and Marsden valleys. Rock protection is required to prevent further riverbank erosion and in-stream gravel traps will be constructed to facilitate the removal of gravel to ensure the streams have sufficient capacity.

<u>THAT</u> \$300,000 be allocated in the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan to allow for recovery works in Brook, Enner Glynn and Marsden valleys.

## **Bridge Street**

4.5 A memo will be circulated to Councillors which will include further design details and costings on the Bridge Street upgrade project.

## Waimea Rd/Motueka St Intersection Upgrade

4.6 As a result of concerns raised during community consultation this project has been delayed and it is now unlikely that this work will be completed in 2012/13 and therefore funding needs to be carried over to the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan.

<u>THAT</u> \$1.1 million of the funding for the Waimea Rd/Motueka St Upgrade be deferred to the 2013/14 financial year.

## **Daelyn Land Purchase**

4.7 A question was raised regarding the Daelyn Land Purchase and the status of the transaction if Tasman District Council was no longer funding this project. Further advice is that there was sufficient funding for this project and it is being fully funded by Nelson City Council.

#### 5. Conclusion

5.1 Making these decisions provides guidance for staff to develop the draft 2013/14 Annual Plan.
